Checklist for Moving and Retiring Abroad

Review Visa Requirements:

- Check out the Department of State's <u>country information page</u> to see whether you require a visa to travel or live in your destination country
 - Apply for your visa online or visit your local embassy or consulate to apply

Prepare Documents:

Passport

Ensure it's valid for at least the next six months

Medical records

- Information on any pre-existing health conditions
- Immunization records
- Social Security card if you have one
- Insurance documents
- Bank information
- Driver's license or international driving permits
- Birth certificate
- Flight information
- Visa if required
- Work permit if required
- Copy of important documents

Make Health Care Preparations:

- Check whether you <u>need vaccinations</u> before arriving in your destination country
 - □ Book any necessary vaccine appointments
- Ask your doctor to provide several months worth of prescriptions if you have pre-existing health conditions
 - Get a doctor's letter explaining your prescriptions so you can get through border security
- Do a health checkup before you leave

Plan Your Finances:

- Inform your current bank about your move
 - Set up an account you can use overseas or create a local bank account once you move
- Find out the current exchange rate
 - Get some local currency in advance
- Create a monthly budget
- Prepare to make U.S. tax payments (you have an automatic two-month extension):
 - Have your Social Security number (SSN) or individual taxpayer identification number (ITIN) ready
 - Fill out your tax return in U.S. dollars
 - Mail your tax return to the Internal Revenue Service Center or file electronically using Free File
