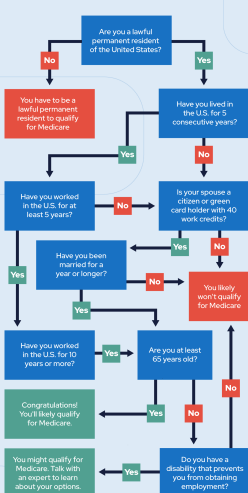

2021 Cost of Medicare for Permanent Residents and Citizens

A

Medicare Part A

Standard premium: Free with 10 years of work
Standard deductible: Varies by service

B

Medicare Part B

Standard premium: \$148.50 per month
Standard deductible: \$203 per year

C

Medicare Part C

Standard premium: Varies by plan
Standard deductible: Varies by plan

D

Medicare Part D

Standard premium: \$43.07 per month
Standard deductible: Maximum \$445 per year

Important Info To Know



To avoid incurring late penalties, enroll in Medicare within your initial enrollment period.



You can still purchase Medicare Part A if you don't have the 10-year required work credits.



If you choose to purchase Medicare Part A, you must first purchase Medicare Part B coverage.



If you receive Social Security benefits, you may be automatically enrolled in Medicare.

Other Insurance Options if You're Ineligible for Medicare



Travel Insurance

For personal and financial risks that may occur while in a foreign country



Senior Health Insurance

Private insurance coverage for elderly individuals who don't qualify for Medicare



New Immigrant Insurance

Health coverage for legal immigrants who don't qualify for Medicare
